The registration and supply fee as well as postdated cheques payable for the first of each month, Sept. through June, or a lump sum payment, are required to hold your child's spot. If for any reason your child will be leaving the program, or not starting the program with us after having been registered, we will require one month's written notice eg. If you will not be starting in Sept. **notice must be given by July 31.** Due to the challenge of filling a spot in May or June, if April will be your child's last month, we are

unable to refund May and June fees. All cheques will be returned once we receive 30 days written notice of withdrawal. Partial months will not be refunded.

Dear Parents:

Welcome to Wee Care Preschool! It is our deepest desire that both you and your family have a positive experience with us, and that as you look back, you will have many happy memories of your year(s) spent as part of our Wee Care Preschool family.

OUR PHILOSOPHY:

We believe that each child is special and we appreciate and enjoy each one for their own unique personality. Our goal at preschool is to provide the best entry possible into your child's educational journey. Experts agree that preschool age children learn through play. We encourage a love of learning by making learning fun during these carefree years, and by providing experiences and equipment to facilitate learning in a safe environment. Our preschool curriculum consists of themes based on topics which will interest children. Each month, many activities will take place which promote basic concepts (introduction to letter and number recognition, color and shape recognition, large and small motor skills development, etc.) While we present opportunities which facilitate learning, children are never pushed to do more than they are ready for. Our goal is to prepare them for future school years by introducing them to basic classroom protocol such as sharing materials, taking turns, respecting personal space and property and following directions.

It is normal for children to complain about their friends from time to time. Each child has a different personality and they won't always agree with each other on what to play or how things should be done. Don't worry. We will always do our best to take good care of them and help resolve any conflicts that may arise as they interact. If you have a concern, please talk to us. We believe in open dialogue between teachers and parents at all times, and we consider ourselves to be very approachable. Please stay after class or call us at the home numbers provided if you wish to discuss a concern.

VOLUNTEERS

We will need volunteers at times throughout the year. Please let us know if you are interested in helping in any way. We greatly appreciate your assistance! We realize many parents are working outside the home and cannot volunteer their time. This is not a problem; please do not feel obligated.

DISCIPLINE:

At preschool our positive approach to discipline is two-fold. We teach respect for other people and respect for property. Therefore we don't allow children to hit, shove or verbally hurt each other. We also reinforce that children treat material possessions (ours or theirs) with respect. Occasionally, they may not behave in respectful ways. When this happens we give two reminders of the proper behavior. If the behavior is repeated a third time, a "time out" chair is used for an appropriate time (2-5 minutes.). We resolve the situation by dialoging using a problem-solving technique. We will skip the reminders and go straight to "time out" if the behavior involves hitting or any other physical offense toward another child. We will always inform the parent if a child's behavior is consistently problematic. Hopefully our philosophy on discipline will be similar to what is expected and practiced in your home. It is our goal to work together with you for the good of all our students.

RELIGIOUS PRACTICES:

We understand that religious teachings are the choice of the parents, but it may happen that the subject of God is mentioned in conversation. We will say a simple grace before snack time and occasionally a Bible story may be told during circle time if it fits in with our unit of study, such as at Christmas time. We also have parties to celebrate Christmas and Easter. If you object to your child participating, please let us know.

CLASS TIME: A.M. 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. Full Day 9:00 a.m. – 3:20 p.m.

We would like you to bring your child into the school, stay with him/her while they take off necessary outerwear, then bring them to the classroom door, making sure the teacher is aware of their arrival. It has been our experience that a quick, positive separation is easier on both child and parent alike. We are always available to comfort a crying child. It is not uncommon for children to need time to make the transition to beginning a preschool routine. At the end of class we ask that you come into the school. We will release your child to you as we see you arrive at the classroom door. Please inform us if someone other than a parent will be picking up your child.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE :

IS AVAILABLE AT \$6.00 PER HOUR - 7:45 – 9:00 am, Mon. thru Thurs. morning as well as Mon. and Wed. 3:20 – 4:00 p.m.

ILLNESS:

If your child has been ill within the last twenty-four hours, please keep him/her at home. If they have vomited the night before and seem fine the next day, they are more than likely still contagious to others. All the children use the same washroom and play with the same toys, so it is very difficult to keep a sick child from infecting others. Your child is welcome to attend if they have a minor complaint (i.e. mild cold) but are still happy and energetic enough to enjoy the day's activities.

SNACK TIME:

We ask our parents to provide a small, preferably nutritious snack on a rotating basis. Please send enough snack for 21 children (for both morning and afternoon for full day preschool), when it is your child's turn. Some suggestions, which most children enjoy, are cheese and crackers, pre-cut vegetables and dip, fruit & fruit dip, mini muffins, sandwiches, yogurt or mini bagels. We ask that you **NOT** send any snack with **peanuts, peanut butter or any kind of nuts**, even on days when your child brings his or her own individual snack. Please check labels; Ritz Bits with cheese and some types of yogurt as well as item bought in bulk may contain traces of peanuts. We have had students with life-threatening allergies to nuts. We want to take every precaution to keep our students safe from any allergic contact. We will inform you of any other food allergies in the class so we can avoid these foods, as we don't want these children to feel left out at snack time. We will send a "snack buddy" (a stuffed animal), home with your child on the school day prior to your snack turn. This is a fun way for you and your child to be reminded of your upcoming snack day. The "snack child" is also "line leader" for the day, and will have the privilege of wearing a special badge. If your child has not been given a buddy prior to his snack day, please remind us. The buddy is to be returned with the snack. We will also be having several party days on which parents or the child's guests will be welcomed. These parties are a type of "pot luck" with parents signing up for items needed for our special day. An individual bagged lunch will be a treat for "party days" that are designated for the children only. We will celebrate every child's birthday by providing an artificial cake with a candle for them to blow out, and singing to the birthday child. They will also receive a gift certificate to choose a book from the Scholastic Books flyer as a birthday gift.

STAR OF THE WEEK:

Each child will have a turn at being our "Star of the Week". On their special day, each child will be shown our appreciation for their contribution for making our preschool class a great place to be. We will celebrate the uniqueness of each child by having them share their own personal story with us. A bag containing a special class binder as well as books and a will be sent home to share with your child on their special day. They may keep this bag for one week. He or she will also receive a "Star of the Week" badge to keep.

CLOTHING:

We ask that your child wear washable play-type clothing to school so they will be free to play and have fun, and possibly get a little dirty at times. It would be greatly appreciated if the child's clothing would be easy enough to fasten and unfasten in the bathroom without any assistance. Please send in your child's backpack: clean, non-marking shoes or gripper slippers as well as a change of clothing in case of mishaps. We have a lost and found box, located in the hallway on top of the coat racks. Please check it periodically for your child's belongings. It is helpful to label your child's belongings. Your child is also to have a labelled water bottle, which will be taken home each day.

TOYS:

We prefer that your child not bring any toys from home to play with at school. All toys at school must be shared with the others and we don't want your child's special toy to get broken or lost. We are sure your child will be thrilled with the great variety of toys available at preschool.

SCHOOL CANCELLATION:

We, as a preschool, are not affiliated with the church. However, because we are renting space from the church there may be times when we will have to cancel a class due to a funeral. If either the public or separate schools cancel due to severe weather conditions, we will also cancel classes.
